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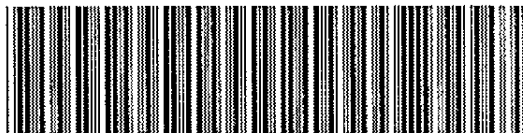

ARTICLE I

The name of this corporation shall be: LEGUINA LANDSCAPING, INC

This corporation shall commence existence upon the filling of these Articles of Incorporation by the Department of State, State of Florida and shall have perpetual existence.

To lend money to, and use its credit to assist, its officers and employees in accordance with Florida Statute S607.141;

To purchase. Take, receive, subscribe for, or otherwise acquire, own, hold, vote, use, ----- employ, sell, mortgage, lend, ledge or otherwise dispose of and otherwise use and deal in and with shares or other interest in, or obligations of, other domestic of foreign ----- corporations associations, partnerships or individuals or direct or indirect obligations of the United States or of any other government, stat, territory, governmental district or municipality or of any instrumentality thereof;

To be a promoter, incorporator, partner, member, associate or manager of any corporations partnership, joint venture, trust or other enterprise.


ARTICLE IV


