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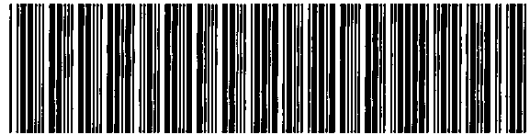



The undersigned subscriber to these Articles of Incorporation hereby forms a Corporation for profit under the laws of the State of Florida.

ARTICLE I - NAME

The name of the corporation shall be: STEPHEN J. OBRIEN, INC.
The principal place of business will be 105 4TH Av. NE, #414, St. Petersburg, FL 33701.

ARTICLE II - DURATION

This corporation shall have perpetual existence.

ARTICLE III - PURPOSE
