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ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION
OF
AHP OF ORLANDO, INC.

AHP of Orlando, Inc. (the "Corporation"), in compliance with the Florida Business Corporation Act, F.S. § 607.0101, *et. seq.*, and/or the Florida Professional Service Corporation and Limited Liability Company Act, F.S. § 621.01, *et. seq.*, hereby adopts the following Articles of Incorporation.

ARTICLE I - NAME

The name of the Corporation shall be AHP of Orlando, Inc.

ARTICLE II - REGISTERED OFFICE AND AGENT

The mailing address of the registered office of the Corporation is 515 E. Park Avenue, Tallahassee, Florida 32301. The name of its initial registered agent at such office is CorpDirect Agents, Inc.

ARTICLE III - PRINCIPAL OFFICE

The principal place of business and the mailing address of the Corporation is 3079 Peachtree Industrial Boulevard, Duluth, Georgia 30097.

ARTICLE IV - PURPOSE

The purpose of the Corporation is:

- (1) To provide medical and other professional health care services to the general public in the State of Florida through individual physicians and nurses.
- (2) The Corporation may do all and everything necessary and proper for the accomplishment of the stated purposes herein or the attaining of any of the objects, or furtherance of any of the purposes, enumerated in these Articles of Incorporation or any amendments hereof; necessary or incidental for the protection and benefit of the Corporation; and necessary and proper for carrying out, either alone or in association with other firms, individuals, corporations, or associations, any lawful pursuit necessary or incidental to accomplishment of the purposes or attainment of the objects of the Corporation and the furtherance of such purposes or objects.

The foregoing paragraphs shall be construed as enumerating both objects and purposes of this Corporation, and it is hereby expressly provided that the foregoing enumeration of specific purposes shall not be held to limit or restrict in any manner the purposes of the Corporation otherwise permitted by law.

ARTICLE V - SHARES

The Corporation shall have the authority to issue 1,000 shares of common stock, par value \$0.01 per share.

ARTICLE VI - GOVERNING PERSON EXCULPATION

To the fullest extent not prohibited by law, a director of the Corporation shall not be personally liable to the Corporation or its shareholders for monetary damages for an act or omission in the director's capacity as a director, except for liability for (a) breach of the director's duty of loyalty to the Corporation or its members, (b) an act or omission not in good faith that constitutes a breach of duty of the director to the Corporation or that involves intentional misconduct or a knowing violation of the law, (c) a

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transaction from which the director received an improper benefit, whether or not the benefit resulted from an action taken within the scope of the director's office, or (d) an act or omission for which the liability of the director is expressly provided by an applicable statute.

ARTICLE VII- INCORPORATION

The name of the Incorporator is D. Dewayne Nichols and the address of the Incorporator is 1000 Louisiana Street, Suite 1800, Houston, Texas 77002.


