ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

No share in series. The corporation is not authorized to issue shares in series.

FOURTH: The amount of capital with which this corporation shall begin business is not less than five hundred (\$500.00) dollars.

FIFTH: The period of duration of the corporation is perpetual.
