ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

FIRST ACADEMIC ENTERPRISE, INC

The undersigned subscriber to these Articles of Incorporation, a natural person competent to contract, hereby forms a corporation not for profit under the laws of the State of Florida.

ARTICLE I - CORPORATE NAME

The name of this corporation is:

FIRST ACADEMIC ENTERPRISE, INC

ARTICLE II - NATURE OF CORPORATE BUSINESS

The general nature of the business to be transacted by this corporation is as follows:

- (a) To operate and manage an educational business that will include day care centers, charter schools and night schools and the engaging in, of any other business incidental and pertinent thereto.
- (b) To acquire by purchase, subscription or otherwise and to hold for the purpose of investment or otherwise, and to own, sell or otherwise dispose of and deal in stocks, bonds, mortgages, securities, notes, commercial papers, or otherwise deal with other evidence of debt, issued by any government, state, county or other public authority, or by any one or more persons, firms, corporations, or associations, either foreign or domestic, and whether now or hereafter organized, and while the owner thereof, to execute

all of the rights, powers and privileges of ownership; to guarantee or become surety with respect to any obligations of any said persons, firms, corporations or associations contained in any of said securities.

- (c) To purchase real estate and to build upon or in any manner improve any real estate owned by it.
- (d) To organize or cause to be organized under the laws of the State of Florida, or of any other state, district, territory, province or government, a corporation or corporations for the purpose of accomplishing any or all of the objects for which this corporation is organized and to dissolve, windup, liquidate, merge or consolidate any such organization or corporation or to cause the same to be dissolved, windup, liquidated, merged or consolidated.

The foregoing clauses shall be construed both as objects and powers; and the foregoing enumeration of specific powers shall not be held to limit or restrict in any manner the powers of the corporation and it is the intention that the foregoing purposes, objects, and powers specified in each of the Paragraphs of Article II of this Certificate of Incorporation shall, except as otherwise specifically provided, in no way be limited under the terms of any other clauses, or paragraphs of this Article or any other Articles or paragraphs of this Article and shall be regarded as independent purposes, objects and powers.

ARTICLE III - CAPITAL STOCK

The maximum number of shares that this organization is authorized to having outstanding at any time is Five Thousand (5,000) shares of Common Stock having a par value of One Dollar (\$1.00) per share. The consideration to be paid for each share of stock shall be fixed by the Board of Directors.
