**ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

The undersigned, acting as Incorporator of a corporation under the Florida General Corporation Act, adopt the following Articles of Incorporation for such corporation:

ARTICLE I - NAME AND ADDRESS OF CORPORATION

The name of the corporation is **ASAP SERVICE & TECHNOLOGY, INC.** The Corporation shall be referred to in this instrument as "the Corporation"; these Articles of Incorporation as "Articles"; and the Bylaws of the corporation as "Bylaws".

ARTICLE II - TERM OF EXISTENCE

The period of duration of the corporation is perpetual.

ARTICLE III - PURPOSE

The purpose for which the corporation is organized is commercial communications and all other lawful activities that are not forbidden by the Florida corporation laws or by other laws or by these Articles of Incorporation.

ARTICLE IV - AUTHORIZED SHARES

The corporation shall have the authority to issue is One Thousand (1,000) shares of corporate stock.

ARTICLE V - INITIAL REGISTERED OFFICE & AGENT

The street address in Florida of the initial registered office of the corporation is 11970 N. Elbon Point, Dunnellon, Florida and the name of the initial registered agent at such address is Richard Cunningham, Jr.

ARTICLE VI - DIRECTORS

The Board of Directors of the corporation shall consist of two (2) directors. The number of directors may be increased from time to time by a vote of the Shareholders of the corporation but shall never be less than one.

ARTICLE IX - AMENDMENT OF ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

The shareholders shall have the power to adopt, amend, alter, change or repeal the Articles of Incorporation when proposed and approved at a stockholders' meeting, with not less than a two-thirds vote of the issued stock.

ARTICLE X-NON-RESIDENT DIRECTORS

Directors need not be residents of this state or country or shareholders of this Corporation unless the Articles of Incorporation or Bylaws so require.

ARTICLE XI- DIRECTORS AUTHORITY TO FIX COMPENSATION

Directors shall have authority to fix the compensation of themselves and all officers and employees unless otherwise provided in these Articles or By-laws.

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ARTICLE XII-INFORMAL ACTIONS OF DIRECTORS

If all the Directors severally or collectively consent in writing to any action taken or to be taken by the corporation, and the writings evidencing their consent are filed with the Secretary of the corporation, the action shall be as valid as though it had been authorized at a meeting of the Board of Directors.

ARTICLE XIII-REMOVAL OF DIRECTORS

At a meeting of voting shareholders called expressly for that purpose, any one director, or the entire board of directors, may be removed with or without cause, by a vote of the holders of 60 percent of the shares then entitled to vote at an election of directors.
