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

Amendment to the articles of incorporation of Concorde Services, Inc

Article III: Community Development and Qualified Opportunity Zone Fund

Section 1: Purpose

The corporation recognizes the importance of community development and fostering economic growth within underserved communities. To this end, the corporation is committed to contributing to the wellbeing of these communities and will engage in activities aimed at their improvement.

Section 2: Community and Workforce Development Activities

The Board of Directors is hereby authorized to identify and execute community development activities which may include, but are not limited to:

- 1. Investing in Community-based Projects: Including both infrastructure and social programs aimed at community improvement.
- 2. Funding or Organizing Educational Programs: Initiatives may target skill-building, literacy, or other educational needs.
- 3. Workforce Development: Focus on training programs, vocational education, apprenticeships, or other initiatives aimed at enhancing employment skills in underserved and HUBZone communities.
- 4. Job Creation: Engaging in direct hiring, partnering with local organizations for job fairs, or investing in businesses with a strong potential for employment growth in underserved and HUBZone communities.
- 5. Supporting Housing Initiatives: Targeting disadvantaged communities for affordable housing projects.
- 6. Participation in Public Infrastructure Projects: Such as public transportation, roads, and community centers.

7. Other Activities: As identified by the Board, which align with the purposes of community and workforce development.

Section 3: Qualified Opportunity Zone Fund Creation

- 1. Authorization: The Board of Directors is authorized to establish a Qualified Opportunity Zone Fund as defined by the Tax Cuts and Jobs Act of 2017, Section 1400Z or any succeeding legislation.
- 2. Purpose: The primary purpose of the Qualified Opportunity Zone Fund will be to invest in qualified opportunity zones, aiming for both financial returns and community improvement.
- 3. Management: The fund shall be managed by the Board of Directors or by a committee designated by the Board for this purpose.
- 4. Compliance: The corporation will adhere to all federal and state laws and regulations applicable to Qualified Opportunity Zone Funds.
- 5. Reporting: The Board of Directors will provide an annual report on the activities and financial status of the Qualified Opportunity Zone Fund to all shareholders.

Section 4: Amendments

Amendments to this Article has been authorized by a majority of shareholders.

Adoption of Amendment

This amendment was proposed on 08/13/2023 and was duly adopted by a majority vote of the Board of Directors on 09/06/2023.
