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**ARTICLES OF AMENDMENT TO  
THE ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION  
OF REMOTE INTERPRETING, INC**

Pursuant to the provisions of Sections 607.1006 and 607.1007 of the Florida Business Corporation Act, the undersigned Florida corporation hereby adopts the following Articles of Amendment to its Articles of Incorporation:

1. The name of the corporation is **REMOTE INTERPRETING, INC**, hereinafter referred to as the "Corporation".

2. Article I of the Articles of Incorporation of the Corporation is hereby amended to read as follows:

**ARTICLE I - NAME**

"The name of the Corporation is Remote Interpreting, Inc."

3. Article IV of the Articles of Incorporation of the Corporation is hereby amended to read as follows:

**ARTICLE IV - SHARES**

**"Authorized Shares:** The Corporation is authorized to issue One Hundred Thousand (100,000) shares of common stock, \$.01 par value per share."



5. There was not more than one voting group entitled to vote separately on the amendment set forth herein.

6. The effective date of the amendment to the Articles of Incorporation of the Corporation set forth herein will be as of the date of filing these Articles of Amendment to the Articles of Incorporation with the Florida Department of State.
