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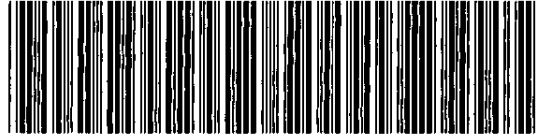

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

THE NOBLE LAW GROUP, P.A.

(A professional corporation pursuant to Chapters 607 and 621 of the Florida Statutes)

The undersigned, for the purpose of forming a professional corporation under the laws of the State of Florida, adopts the following Articles of Incorporation:

ARTICLE I: NAME

The name of this corporation shall be:

THE NOBLE LAW GROUP, P.A.

ARTICLE II: DURATION

This corporation shall exist perpetually.

ARTICLE III: NATURE OF BUSINESS

This corporation may engage in every aspect of the business of rendering the same professional service to the public that an Attorney At Law, duly licensed under the laws of Florida is authorized to render. This corporation may engage or transact in any lawful activities or business permitted under the laws of the United States, the laws of the State of Florida, or the laws of any other state, country, territory or nation.

The practice of law by and through the corporation's shareholders, directors, officers, agents and professional employees, shall comply with the licensure requirements of the laws of the State of Florida and the laws of any other state in which the corporation engages in the practice of law. In addition, there shall be compliance by all aforementioned parties of the corporation, to all of the rules and regulations controlling the practice of law.

The corporation may employ ancillary personnel to work at the direction and under the supervision of the personnel who are licensed to practice law.

However, a fiduciary representative of the estate of a lawyer who was a shareholder in the corporation may hold the entirety of the decedent lawyer's interest or stock in the corporation for a reasonable time during the estate administration.

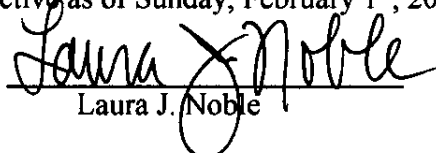
