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

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF BELLESA GRANITE AND MARBLE, INC.

In compliance with Chapter 607, and/or Chapter 621, F.S. (Profit), the undersigned person(s), acting as incorporator(s) of a corporation organized under the laws of the State of Florida, hereby adopt(s) the following Articles of Incorporation:

ARTICLE ONE CORPORATE NAME

The name of the corporation shall be:

BELLESA GRANITE AND MARBLE, INC.

ARTICLE TWO INITIAL PRINCIPAL OFFICE

The principal place of business and the mailing address of this corporation shall be:

1105 DONNELL DRIVE VOLUSIA COUNTY PORT ORANGE, FLORIDA 32129

ARTICLE THREE PURPOSE

The purpose for which the corporation is organized is to engage in any lawful activity permitted by the laws of the State of Florida.

ARTICLE FOUR SHARES

The number of shares of stock, which the corporation shall have authority to issue, is 7,500 shares of common stock at a par value of \$100 per share.

ARTICLE FIVE DIRECTORS

The name(s) and residence address(es) of the person(s) constituting the initial Board of Directors is:

After the initial Board of Directors, the Board shall consist of such a number of directors as shall be determined by the shareholders from time to time at each annual meeting at which directors are to be selected.

ARTICLE SIX LIABILITY OF DIRECTORS

To the fullest extent permitted by law, no director of this corporation shall be personally liable to the corporation or its shareholders for monetary damages for breach of any duty owed to the corporation or its shareholders, except that at director may be held personally liable for (1) breaches of the duty of loyalty, (2) acts or omissions not in good faith or which involve intentional misconduct or a knowing violation of law, (3) declaration of unlawful dividends or unlawful stock repurchases or redemptions, or (4) a transaction for which the directors derives an improper personal benefit.

Any director or officer who is involved in litigation or other proceeding by reason of his or her position as a director or officer of this corporation shall be indemnified and held harmless by the corporation to the fullest extent.

ARTICLE SEVEN OTHER PROVISIONS

Preemptive Rights: The Corporation elects to have preemptive rights so that each shareholder has the right to acquire a proportional amount of any shares that are issued.

Director or Officer Interest: In the absence of fraud, no transaction between (a) this corporation and (b) any other association, corporation or any director or officer of this corporation individually, shall be affected by the fact that any director or officer of this corporation is individually a party to the transaction or is interested in or is a director or officer of such other association or corporation.

Stock Transfer Restriction: No shareholder of this corporation shall sell any shares of stock held by him or her in this corporation without first offering to sell such stock to the corporation on the same terms and conditions and at the price offered in good faith and in writing, by any proposed purchaser. The written offer by such proposed purchaser shall be delivered to the corporation at the time the stock is offered to the corporation for sale.

The corporation shall have the right to accept the offer any time within thirty (30) days from and after the date of which the offer is made to the shareholder and shall exercise the option to purchase by notifying the shareholder in writing. If the corporation shall not exercise its option to purchase the shares of stock, it shall notify the shareholder in writing within the thirty (30) day period and the shares may then be sold by the shareholder, but only to the proposed purchaser on the same terms and conditions as offered to the corporation, and only within thirty (30) days from and after the date on which the corporation declines to exercise its option.

Corporate Seal: The Corporation shall have a corporate seal, which shall be affixed to all deeds, mortgages, and other instruments affecting or relating to real estate.

Execution of Written Instruments: All instruments that are executed on behalf of the corporation which are acknowledged and which affect an interest in real estate shall be executed by the President or any Vice-President and the Secretary and/or Treasurer. The President or Vice-President may execute all other instruments executed by the corporation, including a release of mortgage or lien. Notwithstanding the preceding provisions of this section, any written instrument may be executed by any officer(s) or agent(s) that are specifically designated by resolution of the Board of Directors.
