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

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#### ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

The undersigned incorporator, for the purpose of forming a corporation for profit under the Florida Business Corporation Act, hereby adopts the following Articles of Incorporation:

# ARTICLE I

Name

The name of the corporation is:

SANTE SHIPPING LINES, INC.

#### ARTICLE II

#### Purpose

The corporation is organized for the purpose of transacting any and all lawful business for which corporations may be formed under the Florida Business Corporation Act, and all amendments and supplements thereto, or any law enacted to take the place thereof (collectively, the "Act").

# ARTICLE III

#### Authorized Capital

The corporation is authorized to issue Ten Thousand (10,000) shares of common stock, with a par value of \$0.001 per share.

#### ARTICLE V

#### Registered Office and Agent

The street address of the corporation's initial registered office is 1395 Brickell Avenue, 14th Floor, Miami, Florida 33131. The name of the initial registered agent at such office is Fred K. Lickstein.

# ARTICLE VI

# Indemnification

- (a) The corporation shall indemnify, or advance expenses to, to the fullest extent authorized or permitted by the Act, any person made, or threatened to be made, a party to any action, suit or proceeding by reason of the fact that he: (i) is or was a director of the corporation; (ii) is or was an officer of the corporation, provided that he is or was at the time a director of the corporation; or (iii) is or was serving at the request of the corporation as a director, officer, agent or employee of another corporation, partnership, joint venture, trust or other enterprise, provided that he is or was at the time a director of the corporation.
- (b) Except for those persons entitled to indemnification pursuant to subparagraph (a) of this Article VI, the Board of Directors of the corporation shall have, unless otherwise expressly prohibited by the Act, the sole and exclusive discretion, on such terms and conditions as it shall determine, to indemnify, or advance expenses to, any person made, or threatened to be made, a party to any action, suit or proceeding by reason of the fact that he is or was an officer, employee or agent of the corporation, or is or was serving at the request of the corporation as a director, officer, employee or agent of another corporation, partnership, joint venture, trust or other enterprise.
- (c) Except for those persons entitled to indemnification pursuant to subparagraph (a) of this Article VI, no person may apply for indemnification or advancement of expenses to any court of competent jurisdiction.

## ARTICLE VII

## Incorporator

#### ARTICLE VIII

# Board of Directors

This corporation shall have at least one (1) director. The number of directors may be either increased or decreased from time to time by amendment to the By-Laws adopted by the stockholders. The duties and manner of electing or appointing directors shall be as set forth in the By-Laws of the corporation.

The names and addresses of the initial directors, who, unless otherwise provided by law or the corporation's By-Laws, shall serve in such capacity for the first year of existence of the corporation or until their successors are elected or appointed and have qualified, whichever occurs sooner, are as follows:

#### ARTICLE 1X

#### Officers

The officers of this corporation shall include a Chief Executive Office, Vice President, Secretary and Treasurer. Other officers may be established or appointed by the Board of Directors as it may deem appropriate. The qualification, time and manner of election or appointment, the duties, terms of office, and manner of removing officers shall be as set forth in the corporation's By-Laws.
