ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

SOLAR TWENTY TEN, INC.

The undersigned, acting as incorporators of a corporation under the Florida General Corporation Act, adopt the following Articles of Incorporation for such corporation:

ARTICLE I - NAME

The name of the corporation is Solar Twenty Ten, Inc.

ARTICLE II - TERM OF EXISTENCE

The period of duration of the corporation is perpetual.

ARTICLE III - NATURE OF BUSINESS

The purpose for which the corporation is organized is to transacr and or all lawful business and to do all other things incidental to them or connected with them that are not forbidden by the Florida corporation laws or by other law, or by these Articles of Incorporation, and to carry out the said purpose in any state, territory, district, or possession of the United States, or in any foreign country, to the extent that these purposes are not forbidden by the law of the state, territory, district, or possession of the United States, or by the foreign country.

ARTICLE IV - STOCK

<u>Number.</u> The aggregate number of shares that the corporation shall have the authority to issue is One Thousand (1,000) shares of capital stock with a par value of One Dollar (\$1.00) per share.

<u>Initial issue.</u> Five Hundred (500) shares of the capital stock of the corporation shall be issued for cash at a par value of One Dollar (\$1.00) per share.

<u>Stated capital.</u> The sum of the par value of all shares of capital of the corporation that have been issued shall be the stated capital of the corporation at any particular time.

<u>Dividends.</u> The holders of the cutstanding capital stock shall be entitled to receive, when and as declared by the Board of Directors, dividends payable either in cash, in property, or in shares of the capital stock of the corporation.

No classes of stock. The shares of the corporation are not to be divided into classes.

No share in series. The corporation is not authorized to issue shares in series.

<u>Small business stock.</u> To the extent allowed by law, all stock of the corporation shall be treated as IRC Section 1244 (Small Business Stock) for purposes of any loss deductions which a shareholder may be entitled to claim.

ARTICLE V - DATE OF EXISTENCE

This corporation shall begin its existence upon the filing of these Articles with the Secretary of State, and is to exist perpetually, thereafter.

ARTICLE VI - ADDRESS

The initial street address in Florida of the initial principal office of the corporation is 202 SW 33rd Avenue, Unit C, Ocala, FL 34474, and the name of the initial Registered Agent is Brett L. Swigert, P.A.

ARTICLE VII - DIRECTORS

The number of Directors shall be no more than five (5), and no less than one (1) Director, who need not be a resident of the State of Florida or a Shareholder of the corporation.
