ARTICLES OF AMENDMENT TO ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF ATLANTIC MARINE ENGINE, INC.



1. Article III of the Articles of Incorporation of Atlantic Marine Engine, Inc. is amended to read as follows:

ARTICLE III - PURPOSE

This for profit corporation is organized for any lawful purpose pursuant to The Florida Business Corporation Act, §607.0301, Florida Statutes.

2. Article IV of the Articles of Incorporation of Atlantic Marine Engine, Inc. is amended to read as follows:

<u>ARTICLE IV - SHARES</u>

This corporation is authorized to issue and have outstanding at any one time 500 shares of common stock without par value, which shall be designated "common shares". Any and all other classes of shares issued by the corporation are hereby cancelled effective upon the date set forth below.

3. Article IX is added to the Articles of Incorporation of Atlantic Marine Engine, Inc. as follows:

ARTICLE IX. INDEMNIFICATION OF OFFICERS AND DIRECTORS

Every Officer and every Director of the corporation shall be indemnified by the corporation, as permitted by law, against all expenses and liability, including counsel fees, and all fees reasonably incurred by or imposed upon him in connection with any proceeding to which he may be a party or in which he may become involved by reason of his being or having been an Officer or Director of the corporation, whether or not be is an Officer or Director at the time such expenses are incurred. The foregoing rights of indemnification shall be in addition to and not exclusive of all other rights to which such Officer or Director may be entitled.
