

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

ARTICLE I. CORPORATE NAME

The name of this corporation is COLLEGE PARK NUTRITION COMPANY, and has its principal place of business at 1520 Edgewater Drive, Suite J, Orlando, Florida 32804.

ARTICLE II. NATURE OF BUSINESS AND POWERS

The general nature of the business to be transacted by this Corporation is to engage in any and all business permitted under the laws of the State of Florida and this Corporation shall have all of the corporate powers enumerated in the Florida General Corporation Act.

Each Shareholder of the Corporation shall have the right to purchase, subscribe for, or receive a right or rights to purchase or subscribe for, at the price for which it is offered to others, that Shareholder's pro rata portion of the following:

- A. Any stock of any class that the Corporation may issue or sell, whether or not exchangeable for any stock of the Corporation of any class or classes, and whether or not of unissued shares authorized by the Articles of Incorporation as originally filed or by any amendment thereof or out of shares of stock of the Corporation acquired by it after the issuance thereof, and whether issued for cash or other consideration; or,
- B. Any obligation that the Corporation may issue or sell which is convertible into or exchangeable for any stock of the Corporation of any class or classes, or to which is attached or pertinent any warrant or warrants or other instruments conferring on the holder the right to subscribe for or purchase from the Corporation any shares of its stock of any class or classes.

This right shall be deemed waived by any Shareholder who does not exercise it and pay for the shares preempted within thirty (30) days after receipt of written notice from the Corporation stating the price, terms and conditions of the issue of shares and inviting the Shareholder to exercise this preemptive right. This right may also be waived by a written waiver signed by the Shareholder.

ARTICLE VII. BOARD OF DIRECTORS

The Board of Directors shall consist of not less than one (1) Director and not more than fifteen (15) Directors and the total number of Directors may from time to time be increased or decreased in such manner as is described in the Company's By-Laws, provided, however, that the number of Directors shall not be reduced to less than one (1).
