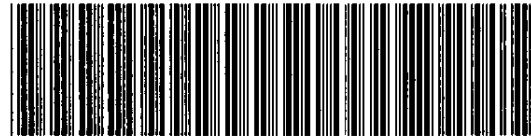

Articles of Incorporation
of
Bruce's Homes, Inc.

Created for the business of real estate sales and related activities.

Article One, The Corporation shall be named, **Bruce's Homes, Inc.**

Article Two, The Corporation is established with the intent of being a "for profit" business entity.

Article Three, The purpose of said Professional Corporation shall be to conduct a "for profit" business operating according the laws of the State of Florida that are established for the regulation of a real estate brokerage company. The primary business shall include work representing the principles of the business and their collective and individual clients to Buy, Appraise, Rent, Sell, Auction, Lease and/or Exchange real property that is located in Florida.

Article Four, The Corporation is established initially with the assets of the skills and knowledge of the principle incorporator who has over 30 years experience and license in real estate related business within the State of Florida. Said license and experience shall be committed to the establishment of business income for the Corporation. The Corporation shall issue 10,000 shares of stock with an initial par value of .01¢ per share.

Article Five, Membership as a director or owner of shares of the Corporation may be restricted by Florida Statutes or rules of the Florida Real Estate Commission. Otherwise, any other natural person who may be invited into control or ownership by existing members and who may offer some asset or tangible benefit to the success of the Corporation may be include in membership.

Article Seven, Directors/Officers:

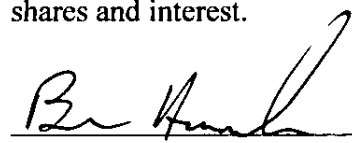
The initial Board of Director shall include one member as follows: Bruce Hancock, Chairman

Article Eight, The Incorporator shall include one natural person as follows: Bruce Hancock

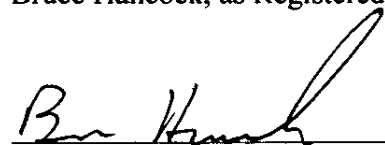
Article Nine, Initially, the Corporation shall have one Director. Other Directors may be elected from time to time by a unanimous consent of the current Director(s). The method of electing new Directors may be changed as needed by unanimous consent of the existing Directors. Directors shall serve in their position for up to two years and then they may be renewed in the office for as many times as they are re-elected to said position by their consent to serve and their election is ratified by at least a simple majority of shareholders of record during any election period.

Article Ten, Profits that may be earned shall be distributed to stockholders according to their shares of ownership in the Corporation, according to a schedule that may be determined by the Directors. If a failure or other termination of the Corporation shall occur, the remaining assets of the Corporation shall be distributed immediately to the shareholders according to their ownership shares and interest.
