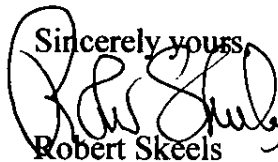

The undersigned, for the purposes of forming a corporation for profit under the laws of the State of Florida, hereby adopt the following Articles of Incorporation:

Article I - Name

Effective Date Feb. 17, 2011

The name of the corporation is CRAWFORD ELECTRICAL CONTRACTING, INC.

Article II - Nature of Business

This corporation may engage in any activity or business permitted under the laws of the United States and the State of Florida.

Article III - Commencement Of Corporate Existence

The board of directors is hereby specifically authorized to make provision for indemnification of directors, officers, employees and agents to the full extent permitted by law.

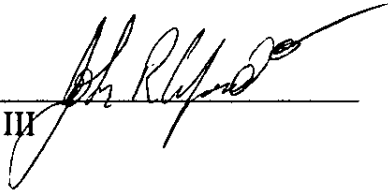
