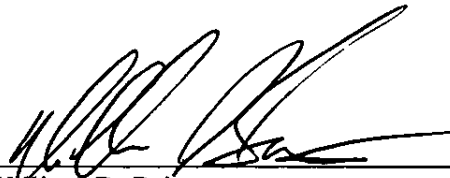
ARTICLE VIII: INDEMNIFICATION

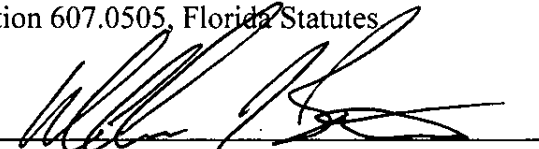
