The undersigned incorporator, who is licensed or otherwise legally authorized to practice the profession of medicine in the State of Florida, executes and files these Articles with the intention of forming a professional corporation in accordance with the *Florida Professional Service Corporation and Limited Liability:Company Act*, and adopts the following Articles of Incorporation for the Corporation:

ARTICLE 1.

1.1 Name and Address. The name of the Corporation is John F. Hoffmann, M.D., P.A., and the mailing address of the Corporation is 6550 NW 110th Street, Reddick, FL 32686. The address of the Corporation's principal office is 6550 NW 110th Street, Reddick, FL 32686.

ARTICLE 2.

2.1 Duration. The period of duration of the Corporation is perpetual.

ARTICLE 3.

- 3.1 <u>Purpose</u>. The purpose of the Corporation is to practice the profession of medicine; the sole and exclusive professional services to be rendered by the Corporation are medical.
- 3.2 <u>Corporate Powers</u>. The Corporation shall have all the rights and powers now or subsequently conferred on professional corporations by the laws of the State of Florida.
- 3.3 <u>Authority of Directors</u>. The board, subject to any specific written limitations or restrictions imposed by law or by these Articles, shall direct the carrying out of the purposes and exercise the powers of the Corporation without previous authorization or subsequent approval by the shareholders of the Corporation.

ARTICLE 4.

- **Stock Certificates.** Certificates of stock shall be signed by the President or the Vice-President, jointly with the Secretary and the seal of the Corporation shall be impressed thereon.
- 4.2 <u>Number of Authorized Shares</u>. The aggregate number of shares that the Corporation shall have authority to issue is 1,000 shares of common stock with par value of \$1.00 per share.
- 4.3 <u>Pre-Emptive Right</u>. The holders of shares of this Corporation shall have pre-emptive rights to purchase any shares of the Corporation hereafter issued or any security exchangeable for or convertible into such shares or any warrants or other instruments evidencing rights or options to subscribe for, purchase, or otherwise acquire such shares.
- **4.4 Shares Not in Classes.** The shares of the Corporation are not to be divided into classes.

ARTICLE 5.

5.1 <u>Cumulative Voting</u>. At all elections of Directors of this Corporation, each shareholder shall be entitled to as many votes as shall equal the number of votes which (except for these provisions as to cumulative voting) he would be entitled to count for the election of Directors with respect to his shares and multiplied by the number of Directors to be elected, and he may count all such votes for a single director, or may distribute them among the number to be voted for, or any two or more of them as he may see fit.

ARTICLE 6.

6.1 <u>Bylaws</u>. The power to adopt, alter or repeal Bylaws shall be vested in the Board of Directors, except where the shareholders specifically provide in any Bylaw made by them that such Bylaws shall not be altered, amended or repealed by the Board.

- <u>Director Conflicts</u>. Any contract or other transaction between the Corporation and one or more of its directors, a committee, shareholders or employees, in which they are interested, or between the Corporation and any Corporation or association of which one or more of its directors and shareholders, members, directors, officers, or employees, or in which they are interested, shall be valid for all purposes, notwithstanding the presence of the director or directors at the meeting of the board of the Corporation that acts upon, or in reference to, the contract or transaction; provided, the interested party does not vote or participate in the action; that the interested party discloses his interest before action is taken, and the contract or transaction is fair and reasonable as to the Corporation at the time it is authorized by the board, a committee or its shareholders. This Section shall not be construed to invalidate any contract or other transaction that would otherwise be valid under the common and statutory law applicable to it.
- 6.3 <u>Indemnification and Related Matters</u>. The Corporation shall indemnify any Officer or Director, or any former Officer or Director, to the full extent permitted by law.
- 6.4 <u>Removal of Directors</u>. At a special meeting of the shareholders called expressly for that purpose, directors may be removed in the manner provided by the Bylaws.
- 6.5 <u>Amendment of Articles of Incorporation</u>. The Corporation reserves the right to amend the Articles in any manner now or hereafter permitted by the law, as provided by the Bylaws.

ARTICLE 7.

7.1 Organizing Director. The initial Board of Directors shall consist of one (1) Director. The number of Directors may be either increased or diminished from time to time by the Bylaws. The name and address of the initial Director of this Corporation is:
