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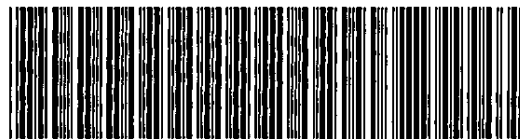



ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

ARTICLE I
NAME AND ADDRESS

The name of this corporation is FIFON, INC. and its principal address and its mailing address is 13126 Regent Circle, Fort Myers, Florida 33966.

ARTICLE II
DURATION

This corporation shall exist perpetually commencing on the date of execution of these Articles of Incorporation.

This corporation reserves the right to amend or repeal any provisions contained in these Articles of Incorporation, or any amendment to them by a two-thirds vote of the shareholders.



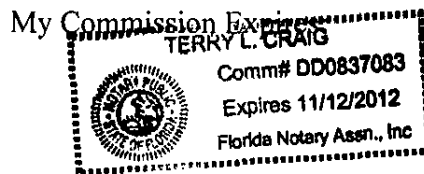


