ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

GMC TILE SERVICES CORP

We, the undersigned, do hereby associate ourselves together and subscribe These Articles of Incorporation for the purpose of forming under the laws of state of Florida, Charter 607 and subject to the following provisions:

ARTICLE ONE:

The name of the Corporation shall be: **GMC TILE SERVICES CORP**

ARTICLE TWO

This corporation shall have perpetual existence and may engage in any activity or business permitted under the laws of the United States and of the State of Florida.

The general nature of business to be transacted by this corporation shall be:

- a) This Corporation is organized for the purpose of engaging in a business organized under Florida General Corporation Law, Chapter 607, and Florida Statutes.
- b) To manufacture, purchase or otherwise acquire, and to own, mortgage, pledge, sell, assign, transfer or otherwise dispose of, and invest in trade in, deal in and with, goods, wares, merchandise, real and personal property, and services of every class, kind and description.
- c) To conduct business in, have one or more offices in, and buy, hold mortgage, sell, convey, lease or otherwise dispose of real and personal property, including franchises, patents, copyrights, trademark, and licenses in the State of Florida, and in all other states, districts, territories, countries or colonies.
- d) To contract debts and borrow money, issue and sell or pledge bonds, debentures, notes and other evidence of indebtedness, and execute such mortgages, transfer of corporate property or other instruments to secure the payment of corporate indebtedness as required.
- e) To purchase the corporate assets of any other corporation and engage in the same or other character of business.

- f) To acquire by purchase, subscription or otherwise and receive, hold, own, guarantee, sell, assign, exchange, underwrite, transfer, mortgage, pledge or otherwise dispose of or deal in and with any of the shares of capital stock or any voting trust certificates in respect of the shares of capital stock, scrip, warrants, rights, bonds, debentures, trust receipts, and other securities, obligations, chose in action and evidence of indebtedness or interest issued or created by any corporation, stock, companies, syndicates, association firms, trusts, or persons, public or private, or by the government of the United States of America, of by any foreign government, or by any state, territory, province, municipality or other political subdivision or by any governmental agency, and as owner thereof, to possess and exercise all the rights, powers and privileges of ownership, including the right, powers and privileges of ownership, including the right to execute consents and vote thereon, and all acts and things necessary or advisable for the preservation, protection, improvement, and enhancement in value thereof.
