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ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

ARTICLE I - NAME

The name of this corporation is:

ARTICLE II - PURPOSE

This corporation is organized for the following purposes:

(a) To engage in the practice of rendering medical services and performing general and surgical orthopedic care.

(b) To purchase, lease, exchange, hire, or otherwise acquire lands or any interest therein, wherever situated; to erect, construct, rebuild, enlarge, alter, improve, maintain, manage, and operate any lands owned or leased by the corporation, or upon any other houses, structures, buildings, or other works of any description on lands; to sell, lease, sublet, mortgage, exchange, or otherwise dispose of any lands or any interest therein, or any houses, structures, buildings, or other works owned, leased, managed or controlled by the corporation; and generally to buy, sell, lease, mortgage, exchange lands or interests in lands, houses, structures, buildings, or other works; and to purchase, acquire, hold, exchange, pledge, hypothecate, sell, and dispose other interests in real estate.

(c) To contract debts and borrow money, issue and sell or pledge bonds, debentures,

notes and other evidences of indebtedness, and execute such mortgages, transfers of corporate property, or other instruments to secure the payment of corporate indebtedness as required.

(d) To purchase the corporate assets of any other corporation and engage in the same or other character of business.

(e) To guarantee, endorse, purchase, hold, sell, transfer, mortgage, pledge or otherwise acquire or dispose of the shares of the capital stock of, or any bonds, securities, or other evidences of indebtedness created by any other corporation of the State of Florida or any other state or government, and while owner of such stock, to exercise all the rights, powers and privileges of ownership, including the right to vote such stock.

(f) To exercise all powers convenient, incident to, or necessary in the proper conduct of its business, which are granted to professional service corporations for profit under the laws of the State of Florida either by the terms of this charter or by virtue of the laws of the State of Florida.

#### ARTICLE III - CAPITAL STOCK

The maximum number of shares of stock that this corporation is authorized to have outstanding at any one time is 1,000 shares of common stock having a nominal or par value of \$1.00 per share; all shares shall be paid in lawful money of the United States of America or in property, labor or services; where said stock is paid for by property, labor or services, the just value thereof shall be fixed by the Board of Directors of the corporation in the manner provided for by the laws of the State of Florida.

#### ARTICLE IV - DURATION

This corporation is to exist perpetually.

#### ARTICLE V - PREEMPTIVE RIGHTS

Every shareholder, upon the sale for cash of any new stock of this corporation of the same kind, class or series as that which he already holds, shall have the right to purchase his pro rata share thereof (as nearly as may be done without issuance of fractional shares) at the price at which it is offered to others.
