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

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

The undersigned incorporator and subscriber to these articles of incorporation adopts these articles to form a corporation in compliance with Chapter 607 and/or Chapter 621, F.S. (Profit), and other laws of the State of Florida.

Article I Name

The name of the corporation is: Sam Ryder Golf, Inc.

Article II Address

Article III Purpose

The corporation is formed to engage in every phase and aspect of golf activities including playing, caddying services, golf course design, golf course management, selling & sponsoring golf course equipment, services, marketing & advertising and any other area to provide a full range of products and services. In addition, the corporation may invest the funds of the corporation in real estate mortgages, stocks, bonds, or any other type of investment, and own real and personal property necessary for the rendering of service to customers.

Article IV Terms of Existence

The corporation is to exist perpetually.

Article V Capital Stock

The corporation shall have the authority to issue 10,000 shares of common capital stock with a par value of \$0.01 per share.

Article IX Restraint on Alienation of Shares

The stockholders of the corporation shall have the power to include in the bylaws, or by separate agreement adopted by a majority of the stockholders of the corporation, any regulatory or restrictive provisions regarding the proposed sale, transfer, or other disposition of any of the outstanding stock of the corporation by any of its shareholders,

or in the event of death of any of its stockholders. The manner and form, as well as the relevant terms, conditions, and details of the disposition, shall be determined by the stockholders of the corporation; provided, however, that such regulatory or restrictive provisions shall not affect the rights of third parties without actual notice of the provisions unless the existence of the provisions are plainly noted on the certificate evidencing the ownership of such stock. No stockholder of the corporation may sell or transfer stock in the corporation unless the sale or transfer has been approved at a stockholder meeting especially called for that purpose.

Article X Indemnification

The corporation shall indemnify its directors, officers, employees, and agents to the full extent permitted by law.

Article XI Amendment

These articles of incorporation may be amended, altered, or changed at any time, and from time to time, in the manner now or hereafter prescribed by the applicable Florida Statutes, and all rights conferred on a stockholder herein are granted subject to this reservation.

Article XII Effective Date

The existence of the corporation shall commence at 12:01 a.m. on May 26, 2012.
