Dear Sir/Madam,

I am an attorney and recently opened my own firm under my maiden name (which is the name that is registered with the Florida Bar), Maria Alejandra Zamora. However, my legal name (as reflected on my social security card, with the IRS, my driver's license, etc.) is Maria Alejandra Zamora Kugler. The name of the corporation is The Law Office of Maria A. Zamora, P.A., document number P12000074289. In the Articles of Incorporation, I used my maiden name when designating the officers of the Corporation, and when declaring myself as the Registered Agent.

I applied for an FEIN with the IRS yesterday, and I had to use my legal name, Maria Alejandra Zamora Kugler to match my social security number information. This morning, I tried to open a bank account for the business, and I was unable to do so because my legal name is required to be reflected in the Articles of Incorporation and on the Sunbiz website.

I called the help hotline this morning, and I was told that I could email an explanation of this error on my part, and that I could request that the Department of State correct my name to reflect my legal name, which is Maria Alejandra Zamora Kugler in all entries in Article 5 – Officers; Article 6 – Director (the Director shall be Maria Alejandra Zamora Kugler.); Article 13 – Registered Office and Registered Agent (the registered agent of this Corporation is Maria A. Zamora Kugler.)

Additionally, I have attached a scanned copy of my driver's license which reflects my legal name and my Florida Bar Card which reflects my maiden/professional name.
