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ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION  
OF  
ATLANTIC DOORS & WINDOWS MANUFACTURING, INC.

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THE UNDERSIGNED, acting as sole incorporator under Chapter 607 of the Florida Business Corporation Act (the "Act"), hereby adopts the following Articles of Incorporation (the "Articles") for ATLANTIC DOORS & WINDOWS MANUFACTURING, INC., a Florida corporation (the "Corporation");

ARTICLE I  
NAME

The name of the Corporation is "*Atlantic Doors & Windows Manufacturing, Inc.*" The name of the Corporation may be changed from time to time by a duly adopted amendment to these Articles.

ARTICLE II  
PURPOSE

The purpose of the Corporation is to engage in any lawful act or activity for which a corporation may be organized under the Act.

ARTICLE III  
SHARES

The number of shares of stock which the Corporation shall have authority to issue is One Thousand (1,000), consisting of a single class of common stock, no par value per share. The shares of stock in the Corporation shall be subject to such restrictions on transfer, pledge or other encumbrance as may be provided under any applicable shareholders' agreement.

ARTICLE IV  
COMMENCEMENT OF CORPORATE EXISTENCE

In accordance with Section 607.0203(1), Fla.Stat., the Corporation's corporate existence shall be deemed to have commenced at 12:01 a.m. on the date of acceptance of these Articles for filing by the Department of State of the State of Florida.

ARTICLE V

**ARTICLE VII**  
**BOARD OF DIRECTORS; OFFICERS**

A. The business and affairs of the Corporation shall be managed by or under the direction of a Board of Directors (the "**Board**"). In addition to the powers and authority conferred upon it by statute or by these Articles or by the Bylaws, but subject to any restrictions contained in the Bylaws or any applicable shareholders' agreement, the Board is hereby empowered to exercise all such powers and do all such acts and things as may be exercised by or done by the Corporation. In addition, the Board may elect such officers of the Corporation as the Board may from time to time determine (collectively, the "**Officers**"). Such Officers shall have the power and authority delegated to them by the Board.

B. The number of directors constituting the initial Board of the Corporation is one (1). Additional directors may be elected at the initial meeting of shareholders of the Corporation in accordance with the Bylaws. The number of directors may be increased or decreased from time to time pursuant to the Bylaws, but in no event shall the number of directors be less than one (1). Unless otherwise provided in the Bylaws, election of directors need not be by written ballot. The names and addresses of the persons who are to serve as initial directors until the first annual meeting of the shareholders of the Corporation or until their earlier death, resignation or removal are as follows:

C. Officers of the Corporation shall be elected, replaced and removed by the Board from time to time in accordance with the Bylaws. Unless otherwise provided in the Bylaws, Officers need not be elected by written ballot. The Officers shall possess the authority and power delegated to them by the Board from time to time in accordance with the Bylaws.

**ARTICLE VIII**  
**BYLAWS; AMENDMENT OF ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION**

The shareholders of the Corporation shall have the sole power to make, adopt, amend, alter or repeal the Bylaws of the Corporation. The Corporation reserves the right to amend or repeal any of the provisions contained in these Articles in any manner now or hereafter permitted by law; *provided, however*, that any amendment to these Articles shall be authorized if and only if such amendment is approved by the shareholders of the Corporation in accordance with the Bylaws.
