ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

BARNSTORM AVIATION HOLDINGS, INC.

The undersigned, for the purpose of forming a corporation for profit under the laws of Florida, adopts the following Articles of Incorporation.

ARTICLE 1

NAME AND ADDRESS

- Section 1.1 Name. The name of the corporation is BARNSTORM AVIATION HOLDINGS, INC.
- Section 1.2 <u>Address of Principal Office</u>. The address of the principal office of the corporation is 11825 Central Expressway, Jacksonville, Florida 32224.
