ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

157 EUREKA GROVE, INC.

THE UNDERSIGNED, acting as sole incorporator under Chapter 607 of the Florida Business Corporation Act (the "Act"), hereby adopts the following Articles of Incorporation (the "Articles") for 157 EUREKA GROVE, INC., a Florida corporation (the "Corporation"):

ARTICLE I NAME

The name of the Corporation is "157 Eureka Grove, Inc." The name of the Corporation may be changed from time to time by a duly adopted amendment to these Articles.

ARTICLE II PURPOSE

ARTICLE VII BOARD OF DIRECTORS; OFFICERS

- A. The business and affairs of the Corporation shall be managed by or under the direction of a Board of Directors (the "Board"). In addition to the powers and authority conferred upon it by statute or by these Articles or by the Bylaws of the Corporation, the Board is hereby empowered to exercise all such powers and do all such acts and things as may be exercised by or done by the Corporation. In addition, the Board may elect such officers of the Corporation as the Board may from time to time determine (collectively, the "Officers"). Such Officers shall have the power and authority delegated to them by the Board.
- B. The number of directors constituting the initial Board of the Corporation is one (1). Unless otherwise provided in the Bylaws, election of directors need not be by written ballot. C. Officers of the Corporation shall be elected, replaced and removed by the Board from time to time in accordance with the Bylaws.
