The undersigned natural person of the age of eighteen (18) years or more, acting as incorporator of a for profit corporation (herein "Corporation") under the Florida statutes, hereby adopts the following Articles of Incorporation for such Corporation.

ARTICLE ONE

ARTICLE TWO

The period of its duration is perpetual.

ARTICLE THREE

The purpose for which the Corporation is organized is to engage in the transaction of any lawful business for which a Corporation may be incorporated under Florida statutes.

The aggregate number of shares which the Corporation shall have the authority to issue is 1,000,000 shares of common stock, each having One Dollar (\$1.00) par value per share.

ARTICLE FIVE

Section 1. Initial Directors. The initial Board of Directors shall consist of one (1) member and the name and address of the person who is to serve as Director until the first annual meeting of the shareholders or until their successors are elected and qualified is:

Section 2. Number and Qualification. The number and qualifications of directors constituting the Board of Directors of the Corporation will be fixed or determined in the manner provided in the Bylaws of the Corporation. Section 2. <u>Bylaws</u>. The Board of Directors will adopt the initial Bylaws, and from time to time may alter, amend or repeal the Bylaws or adopt new Bylaws; but the shareholders from time to time may alter, amend or repeal any Bylaws adopted by the Board of Directors or may adopt new Bylaws.

Section 3. <u>Denial of Preemptive Rights</u>. The shareholders of the Corporation will not have the preemptive right to acquire additional, unissued or treasury shares of the Corporation, or securities of the Corporation convertible into or carrying a right to subscribe to or acquire shares.

Section 4. <u>Limitation of Liability</u>. A director of the Corporation shall not be liable to the Corporation or the shareholders for monetary damages for an act or omission in the director's capacity as a director to the fullest extent allowable under

Florida law, except that this section shall not eliminate or limit the liability of a director for: (i) a breach of a director's duty of loyalty to the Corporation or its shareholders; (ii) an act or omission not in good faith or that involves intentional misconduct or a knowing violation of the law; (iii) a transaction from which a director received an improper benefit, whether or not the benefit resulted from an action taken within the scope of the director's office; (iv) an act or omission for which the liability of a director is expressly provided for by statute; or (v) an act related to an unlawful stock repurchase or payment of a dividend.
