ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF LINDA TUFFREE, P.A.

The undersigned, acting as incorporator of a corporation under the laws of the State of Florida, Florida Statutes Chapters 607 and 621, hereby sets forth and declares:

CHARTER

Article I Name

The name of the corporation shall be LINDA TUFFREE, P.A.

Article II Principal Office -13 OCT 10 AM 8: 04
SECRETARY OF STATE
TALLAHASSEE FLORIDA

The principal place for the transaction of the corporation business shall be 16707 Bobcat Drive, Fort Myers, County of Lee, in the State of Florida, 33908, and the mailing address shall be 16707 Bobcat Drive, Fort Myers, Florida 33908. Said corporation shall have the right and authority to do business at such other place or places within or without the State of Florida as the corporation may, by resolution, designate.

Article III Purpose

The corporation is organized for the purpose of engaging in the field of selling and buying real estate, as a licensed Realtor. The corporation is further organized for the purpose of rendering the foregoing professional services to the public. The corporation shall do everything necessary and proper for the accomplishment of any of the purposes or the attaining of any of the objects, or the furtherance of any of the purposes enumerated in these Articles, or any amendment thereof, necessary or incidental to the protection and benefit of the corporation, and in general, either alone or in association with other corporations, firms or individuals, to carry on any lawful pursuit necessary or incidental to the accomplishment of the purposes or the attainment of the objects or the furtherance of such purposes or objects of the corporation; and to conduct those lawful activities that are authorized under Chapter 621, Florida Statutes, as from time to time amended, and to exercise those powers, rights and procedures set forth in Chapter 607, Florida Statutes, in a manner not inconsistent with Chapter 621, Florida Statutes, and for the purpose of transacting any and all lawful business.

Article IV Term of Existence

The existence of the corporation shall commence upon the filing of these Articles with the Secretary of State of the State of Florida and shall continue thereafter in perpetuity until dissolved as provided by law.

Article V Authorized Shares

The aggregate number of shares the corporation shall have authority to issue shall be 1000 shares of \$1.00 par value common stock, which shall be non-assessable and held, sold, and paid for at such time and in such manner as the Board of Directors may from time to time determine. The shares of the corporation shall not be divided into classes and the corporation is not authorized to issue shares in series.

Article VI Board of Directors

The corporation shall have a Board of Directors of not less than one (1) Director which number may be increased or decreased from time to time. The number of Directors each year shall be determined by the shareholders at their annual meeting, unless the number is fixed by the Bylaws. The initial Director of the corporation shall be:

Article VII Officers

The Officers by whom the business of said corporation shall be conducted shall be a President, who shall be a Director, and a Secretary/Treasurer, and such other officers, agents and factors shall be chosen in such manner, hold their office for such term and have such powers and duties as may be prescribed by the Bylaws or determined by the Board of Directors. Article IX Indebtedness

The amount of indebtedness or liability to which the corporation trany time may subject itself shall be unlimited.

Article X Registered Office and Agent

The street address of the initial registered office of this corporation at that address is Linda Tuffree.

Article XI Preemptive Rights

Without first being offered to the stockholders for subscription, any shares of common stock now or hereafter authorized may be issued: (a) as dividends or in payment of dividends; (b) in exchange for preferred stock or funded debt of the corporation outstanding; (c) to fulfill any outstanding right or option created by the corporation to acquire from the corporation shares of its common stock, or to convert other securities of the corporation into shares of common stock; or (d) pursuant to any amendment to the Articles of Incorporation whereby shares of common stock are changed into a greater number of shares of the same class.

Article XII Bylaws

The initial Bylaws of this corporation shall be adopted by the Board of Directors. The Bylaws may be amended from time to time by either the shareholders or the Directors. The shareholders may amend, alter, or repeal any Bylaw adopted by the Directors. The Directors may not amend, alter, or repeal any Bylaw adopted by the shareholders, nor may the Directors adopt Bylaws which would be in conflict with the Bylaws adopted by the shareholders.

Article XIII Notice

Any subscriber or shareholder present at any meeting, either in person, or by proxy, and any Directors present in person at any meeting of the Board of Directors shall conclusively be deemed to have received proper notice of such meeting unless he shall make objection at such meeting to any defect or insufficiency of notice.

Article XIV Indemnification

Each Director and Officer of the corporation, whether or not then in office, shall be indemnified by the corporation against all cost and expense reasonably incurred or imposed upon him in connection with or arising out of any claim, demand, action, suit or proceeding in which he may be involved or to which he may be made a party by reason of his being or having been a Director or Officer of the corporation, said expense to include attorney fees and the cost of reasonable settlement made with a view to curtailment of cost of litigation, except in relation to matters as to which he finally shall be adjudged in any such action, suit, or proceeding to have been derelict in the performance of his duty as such Director or Officer. Such right of indemnification shall not be exclusive of any other rights to which he may be involved as a matter of law; and the foregoing right of indemnification shall inure to the benefit of the performance of any such Director or Officer.

Article XV Related Transactions

A Director or Officer of the corporation shall not be disqualified by his office from dealing or contracting with the corporation either as a vendor, purchaser, or otherwise, nor shall any transaction or contract of the corporation be void or voidable by reason of the fact that any Director or Officer or any firm of which any Director or Officer is a member or any corporation of which any Director or Officer is a shareholder, Officer, or Director, is in any way interested in such transaction or contract, provided that such transaction or contract is or shall be authorized, ratified, or approved either (a) by a vote of a majority of a quorum of the Board of Directors, without counting in such majority or quorum any Director so interested or member of a firm so interested, or a shareholder, Officer, or Director of a corporation so interested, or (b) by the written consent, or by the vote of any shareholders meeting of the holders of record, of a majority of all the outstanding shares of stock in the corporation entitled to vote, nor shall any Director or Officer be liable to account to the corporation for any profits realized by or from or through any such transaction or contract authorized, ratified, or approved as herein provided by reason of the fact that he, or any firm of which he is a member or any corporation of which he is a shareholder, Officer, or Director, was interested in such transaction or contract. Nothing herein contained shall create liability in the events above-described or prevent the authorized approval of such contracts in any other manner permitted by law.


