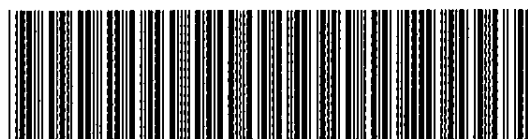

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

OMAC ENTERPRISES, INC.

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I.

The name of the corporation is "OMAC ENTERPRISES, INC."

II.

The corporation is organized pursuant to provisions of the Florida Business Corporation Act.

III.

The corporations shall have perpetual duration.

IV.

The corporation is a corporation for profit organized for the following purposes.

- (a) To market online;
- (b) To engage in any lawful business or activity related thereto; and
- (c) To engage in any other lawful business or activity for which corporations may be organized under the Florida Business Corporation Act.

V.

The corporations shall have the authority to issue no more than one thousand (1,000) shares of common stock having no par value.

VI.

The corporations shall not commence business until it shall have received not less than Five Hundred (\$500.00) and no/100 Dollars in payment for the issuance of shares of stock.

VII.

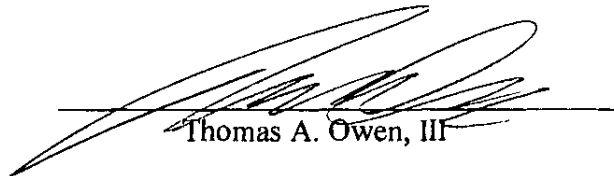
XI.

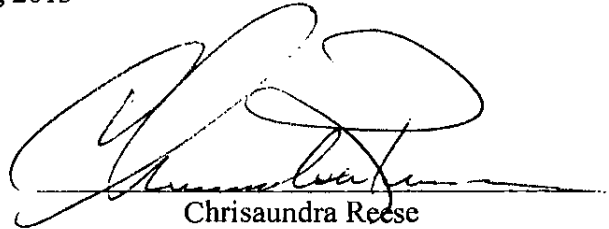
