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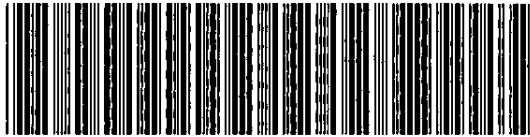

**ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION
OF
Avondale Dental P.A.**

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In compliance with the requirements of Florida Statutes Chapter 621 and Chapter 607, the undersigned hereby acts as incorporator in adopting and filing the following articles of incorporation for the purpose of organizing a professional business corporation.

ARTICLE I

The name of the Professional Corporation is: **Avondale Dental P.A.**

ARTICLE II

The existence of the Professional Corporation shall begin on the date of filing of these Articles of Incorporation with the Florida Department of State.

ARTICLE III

The street address of the principal office of the Professional Corporation is: 3630 St. Johns Avenue, Jacksonville, Florida 32205.
