ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

JAY SAMUEL LEVIN, P.A.

The undersigned being duly licensed to practice law under the laws of the State of Florida, files these Articles of Incorporation for the purpose of forming a Professional Association under and pursuant to the laws of the State of Florida, Section 621, Florida Statutes, providing for the formation, liability, privileges, rights and immunities of a Professional Association for profit, and does hereby organize the Professional Association with the name set forth below and adopts the following Articles of Incorporation:

ARTICLE I - NAME

The name of the Professional Association is Jay Samuel Levin, P.A. (the "Professional Association").

ARTICLE II - TERM OF EXISTENCE

The period of duration of the Professional Association is perpetual.

ARTICLE III – PURPOSE

The Professional Association is formed to engage in every phase and aspect of the practice of law. In addition, the Professional Association may invest the funds of the Professional Association in real estate, mortgages, stocks, bonds or any other type of investment, and own real and personal property necessary for the rendering of professional services.

ARTICLE IV – CAPITAL STOCK

No shareholder shall have any preemptive right whatsoever, and cumulative voting shall not be permitted.

ARTICLE VI - PRINCIPAL PLACE OF BUSINESS

The principal place of business shall be Boynton Beach, Florida, and its mailing address shall be:

ARTICLE VII - REGISTERED AGENT

ARTICLE X - RESTRAINT ON ALIENATION OF SHARES

The shareholders of the Professional Association shall have the power to include in the bylaws, adopted by a majority of the shareholders of the Professional Association, any regulatory or restrictive provisions regarding the proposed sale, transfer or other disposition of any of the outstanding stock of the Professional Association by any of its shareholders, or in the event of the death of any of its shareholders. The manner and form, as well as the relevant terms, conditions and details, of the disposition shall be determined by the shareholders of the Professional Association; provided, however, that such regulatory or restrictive provisions shall not affect the rights of third parties without actual notice of the provisions unless the existence of the provisions is plainly noted on the certificate

evidencing the ownership of such stock. No shareholder of the Professional Association may sell or transfer their stock in the Professional Association except to another individual who is eligible to be a shareholder of the Professional Association and the sale or transfer may be made only after it has been approved at a shareholder meeting especially called for that purpose. If any shareholder becomes legally disqualified to practice law in the State of Florida or is elected to a public office or accepts employment that places restrictions or limitations on their continuous rendering of such professional services, that shareholder's shares of stock shall immediately become subject to purchase by the Professional Association in accordance with the bylaws adopted by the shareholders.

ARTICLE XI - AMENDMENT

The Professional Association reserves the right to amend or repeal any provisions in these Articles of Incorporation in the manner provided by law. Any right conferred on the shareholders is subject to this reservation.
