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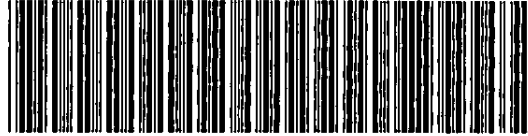



ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION
OF
RICHARD E. SUMNER, MD, P.A.

The undersigned subscriber to these Articles of Incorporation, being duly licensed to practice medicine under the laws of the State of Florida, adopts these articles to form a corporation under the Professional Service Corporation and Limited Liability Company Act, F.S. Chapter 621, and other laws of the state of Florida:

ARTICLE I. NAME

The name of the professional service corporation is RICHARD E. SUMNER, MD, P.A.

ARTICLE II. DURATION

The professional service corporation shall exist perpetually commencing on the date of the filing of these Articles of Incorporation with the Florida Department of State.

ARTICLE III. PRINCIPAL OFFICE OF BUSINESS

ARTICLE IV. PURPOSE

The professional service corporation is formed to engage in every phase and aspect of the practice of medicine. In addition, the corporation may invest the funds of the professional service corporation in real estate, mortgages, stocks, bonds, or any other type of investment, and own real and personal property necessary for the rendering of professional services.

ARTICLE V. CAPITAL STOCK

ARTICLE VIII. TRANSFER OF STOCK

The shareholders of the professional service corporation shall have the power to include in the bylaws, or by separate agreement adopted by a majority of the shareholders of the professional service corporation, any regulatory or restrictive provisions regarding the proposed sale, transfer, or other disposition of any of the outstanding stock of the professional service corporation by any of its shareholders, or in the event of the death of any of its shareholders. The manner and form, as well as the relevant terms, conditions, and details, of the disposition shall be determined by the shareholders of the professional service corporation. No shareholder of the professional service corporation may sell or transfer stock in the corporation except to another individual who is eligible to be a shareholder of the professional service corporation, and the sale or transfer may be made only after it has been approved at a shareholder meeting especially called for that purpose. If any shareholder becomes legally disqualified to practice medicine in the state of Florida, is elected to a public office, or accepts employment that places restrictions or limitations on the continuous rendering of such professional services, that shareholder's shares of

stock shall immediately become subject to purchase by the professional service corporation in accordance with the bylaws adopted by the shareholders.

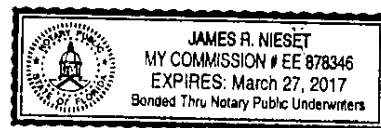
