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**ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

ARTICLE I - NAME OF CORPORATION

proceeding in which he may be involved or with which he may be threatened, both as to action in his official capacity and as to action in another capacity while holding such office, and will continue once that person has ceased to be a director or officer of the corporation. Such indemnification provided will not be deemed exclusive of any other rights to which those indemnified may be entitled under any Bylaw, Agreement or Resolution adopted by the shareholders entitled to vote thereon after notice.

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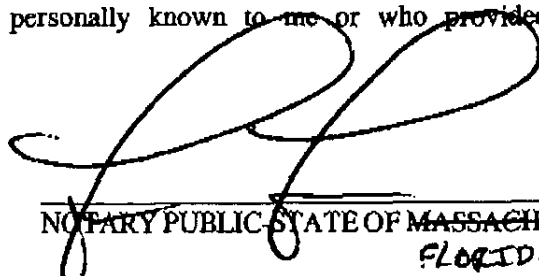
