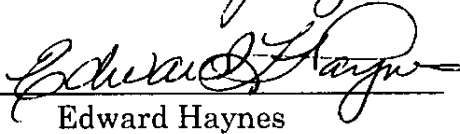
ARTICLE IX

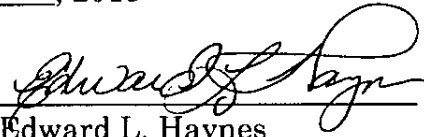
