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ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF MARSHA GERRE MADORSKY, P.A.

The undersigned incorporator to these articles of incorporation hereby forms a professional service corporation (the "Corporation") under the laws of the State of Florida as follows:

ARTICLE I Name, Principal Place of Business, and Mailing Address

The name of the Corporation is: Marsha Gerre Madorsky, P.A. The principal place of business and mailing address are: 2000 South Bayshore Drive, #41, Miami, Florida 33133.

ARTICLE II Term of Existence

The date when corporate existence shall commence shall be the date of the filing of these articles of incorporation by the office of the Florida Department of State and the Corporation shall have perpetual existence thereafter.

ARTICLE III Purpose

The Corporation is organized and shall be operated for the sole and specific purpose of rendering professional legal services.

ARTICLE IV <u>Authorized Shares</u>

The maximum number of shares that the Corporation is authorized to issue is Ten Thousand (10,000) shares of common stock without par value. 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appeal thereof, if he or she acted in good faith and in a manner he or she reasonably believed to be in, or not opposed to, the best interests of the Corporation and, with respect to any criminal action or proceeding, had no reasonable cause to believe his or her conduct was unlawful. The Corporation shall reimburse each person for all costs and expenses, including attorneys' fees, reasonably incurred by him or her in connection with any such liability in the manner provided for by law or in accordance with the Corporation's Bylaws.

The rights accruing to any person under the foregoing provision shall not exclude any other right to which he or she may be lawfully entitled, nor shall anything therein contain or restrict the right of the Corporation to indemnify or reimburse such person in any proper case even though not specifically provided for herein.
