The undersigned hereby makes, subscribes, acknowledges, and files with the Florida Department of State these Articles of Incorporation for the purpose of forming a corporation for profit in accordance with the laws of Florida.

ARTICLE I Name and Street Address

The name of this corporation shall be **DESTIN FISHING FLEET CHARTER SERVICE**, **INC.** and its initial principal street and mailing address is 210 F Harbor Blvd., Destin, FL 32541.

ARTICLE II Term of Existence and Fiscal Year
