The undersigned, for the purposes of incorporating a corporation under the Florida corporation Act, does hereby execute these Articles of Incorporation and does hereby execute these Incorporation and does hereby execute these Articles of Incorporation and does hereby execute these Incorporation and Incorporation

FIRST: The name of the corporation (hereinafter called the "Corporation") is Breakthrough Chronic Care Inc. The principal place of business is 4280 Deste Court, Lake Worth, Florida 33467.

<u>SECOND</u>: The address of the registered office of the Corporation in the State of Florida is 4280 Deste Court, Lake Worth, Palm Beach County, Florida 33467, and the name of the registered agent at that address is Jaroslaw Woloszczuk.

<u>THIRD</u>: The purpose of the Corporation is to engage in any lawful act or activity for which corporations may be organized under the Florida Business Corporation Act.

<u>FOURTH</u>: The Corporation is authorized to issue one hundred million (100,000,000) shares of Common Stock, par value \$0.001 per share.

<u>SEVENTH</u>: The Corporation has three (3) directors initially. The names and addresses of the initial directors are Robert M. Adler, 4280 Deste Court, Lake Worth, Florida 33467, Terry Lord, 2418 Dorrington Street, Houston, Texas 77030, and Jaroslaw Woloszczuk, 1252 Raintree Lane, Wellington, Florida 33414.

<u>EIGHTH</u>: A director of the Corporation shall, to the full extent permitted by the Florida Business Corporation Act as it now exists or as it may hereafter be amended, not be liable to the Corporation or its shareholders for monetary damages for breach of fiduciary duty as a director. Neither any amendment nor repeal of this Article EIGHTH, nor the adoption of any provision of these Articles of Incorporation inconsistent with this Article EIGHTH, shall eliminate or reduce the effect of this Article EIGHTH in respect of any matter occurring, or any cause of action, suit or claim that, but for this Article EIGHTH, would accrue or arise, prior to such amendment, repeal or adoption of an inconsistent provision.

NINTH: The Corporation shall, to the fullest extent permitted by the Florida Business Corporation Act as amended from time to time, indemnify all persons whom it may indemnify pursuant thereto.
