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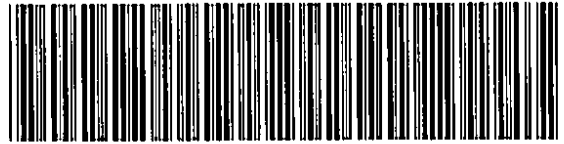

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

of

Spectacular Miami, Inc.

The Undersigned, acting as incorporator of a corporation under the Florida Business Corporation Act, in compliance with Chapter 607, adopts the following Articles of Incorporation for such corporation:

ARTICLE I

NAME:

The name of the corporation is **Spectacular Miami, Inc.**

ARTICLE II

PURPOSE:

The purpose for which the corporation is organized is to provide arts, entertainment, media management and to transact any and all lawful business that is not forbidden by Florida corporation laws or any other law, or by these articles of incorporation, and to carry out the said purpose in any state, territory, district, or possession of the United States, or in any foreign country, to the extent that these purposes are not forbidden by the law of the state, territory, district, or possession of the United States, or by the foreign country.

ARTICLE III

PRINCIPAL OFFICE:

The physical street address in Florida for the principal office of the corporation is 6101 SW 20 Street, Miami, FL 33155.

ARTICLE IV

SHARES:

Number. The aggregate number of shares that the corporation shall have the authority to issue is one hundred (100) shares of Capital Stock, all of which shall be common shares par value.

Initial Issue. One (1) shares of Capital Stock of the corporation shall be the initial issue.

Stated Capital. The sum of the issue value of all shares of Capital of the corporation that have been issued shall be the stated capital of the corporation at any particular time.

Dividends. The holders of the outstanding capital stock shall be entitled to receive, when and as declared by the Board of Directors, dividends payable either in cash, property, or in shares of capital stock of the corporation.

No classes of stock. The shares of the corporation are not divided into classes.

No shares in series. The corporation is not authorized to issue shares in series.

The Initial board of directors shall consist of one (1) member, who need not be a resident of the State of Florida or a shareholder of the corporation.

The corporation shall indemnify any officer or director, or any former officer or director, to the fullest extent permitted by law. The Corporation shall indemnify any Director or Officer of the Organization and who was or is a party or is threatened to be made a party to any proceeding (which shall include for the purposes of this Article any threatened, pending, or completed action, or other proceeding whether civil, criminal,

administrative, or investigative (other than an action by or in the right of the Corporation)) by reason of the fact that such person was or is an authorized representative of the Organization against expenses (which shall include for purposes of this Article attorney's fees), judgments, fines, and amounts paid in settlement actually and reasonably incurred by such person in connection with such action or proceeding if such person acted in good faith and in a manner such person reasonably believed to be in, or not opposed to, the best interests of the Organization and, with respect to any criminal proceeding, had no reasonable cause to believe such person's conduct was unlawful.
