The undersigned incorporator(s), for the purpose of forming a corporation under the Florida Business Corporation Act, hereby adopt(s) the following Articles of incorporation.

ARTICLE I - NAME & ADDRESS

ARTICLE XIII - POWERS


This Corporation shall have all powers necessary or convenient to effect its purpose as enumerated in the Florida General Corporation Act.


