**ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION**

In compliance with the requirements of the Florida Business Corporation Act (as amended or supplemented from time to time, the "**FBCA**") and for purposes of forming a corporation governed by the FBCA, the undersigned hereby acts as an incorporator in adopting and filing these Articles of Incorporation (these "**Articles of Incorporation**").

**ARTICLE I: NAME**

The name of the corporation formed pursuant to these Articles of Incorporation shall be "Personalogix Health Academy, Inc." (the "**Corporation**").

Any amendment, repeal, or modification of this Article X shall not adversely affect any right or protection hereunder of any person in respect of any act or omission occurring prior to the time of such repeal or modification.

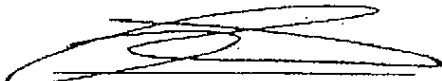
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**ARTICLE XI: POWER TO AMEND OR REPEAL BYLAWS**
