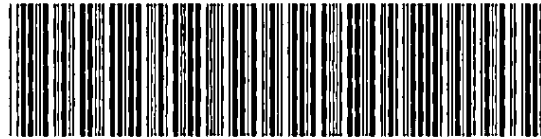


**ARTICLE IV
