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**ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION
OF

In compliance with the requirements of the Florida Business Corporation Act (the "FBCA"), the undersigned hereby acts as an incorporator in adopting and filing these Articles of Incorporation of Three P.be, Inc. (these "**Articles**").

ARTICLE I: NAME

The name of the corporation formed under the FBCA pursuant to these Articles shall be "Three P.be, Inc." (the "Corporation").

ARTICLE II: INITIAL PRINCIPAL OFFICE

The street and mailing address of the initial principal office of the Corporation is 225 South Swoope Avenue, Suite 105, Maitland, Florida 32751.

ARTICLE III: PURPOSE

The Corporation is organized to transact any or all lawful business for which corporations may be incorporated under the FBCA as it now exists or may hereafter be amended or supplemented.

ARTICLE IV: SHARES

The total number of shares that the Corporation is authorized to issue and have outstanding at any time is 1,000 (one thousand), all of which shall consist of a single class of common stock with no par value.

ARTICLE V: CUMULATIVE VOTING

All shareholders are entitled to cumulate their votes for directors pursuant to Section 607.0728(3) of the FBCA.

ARTICLE VI: INITIAL DIRECTORS

The initial board of directors of the Corporation shall consist of such number of members as is determined by the undersigned incorporator. This number may be increased or decreased from time to time in accordance with the Corporation's bylaws, but shall never be less than one. The members of the initial board of directors of the Corporation shall be elected by the undersigned incorporator. Thereafter, the number of members of the board of directors of the Corporation, and the persons duly elected as members of the board of directors of the Corporation, shall be determined in accordance with the duly adopted bylaws governing the Corporation.

ARTICLE VII: INITIAL REGISTERED OFFICE AND AGENT

The street address of the initial registered office of the Corporation is 100 South Orange Avenue, Suite 1000, Orlando, Florida 32801. The name of the initial registered agent of the Corporation at that office is Watson Sloane PLLC.

The Corporation shall indemnify, advance expenses, and hold harmless, to the fullest extent permitted by the FRCIA and other applicable law as it presently exists or may hereafter be amended, any person (a "Covered Person") who was or is made or is threatened to be made a party or is otherwise involved in any action, suit, or proceeding, whether civil, criminal, administrative, or investigative, and whether formal or informal in "Proceeding"), by reason of the fact that he or she, or a person for whom he or she is the legal representative, is or was a director or officer of the Corporation or, while a director or officer of the Corporation, is or was serving at the request of the Corporation as a director, officer, employee, or agent of another corporation or of a partnership, joint venture, trust, enterprise, or nonprofit entity, including service with respect to employee benefit plans, against all liability, damages, and loss suffered and expenses (including attorneys' fees) actually and reasonably incurred by such Covered Person. Any amendment, repeal, or modification of this Article IX shall not adversely affect any right or protection hereunder of any person in respect of any act or omission occurring prior to the time of such repeal or modification.

ARTICLE IX: EFFECTIVE DATE AND TIME

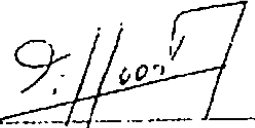

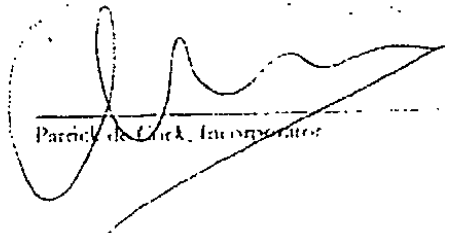
