ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF THREE P.BE, INC.

In compliance with the requirements of the Florida Business Corporation Act (the "FBCA"), the undersigned hereby acts as an incorporator in adopting and filing these Articles of Incorporation of Three P.be, Inc. (these "Articles").

ARTICLE I: NAME

The name of the corporation formed under the FBCA pursuant to these Articles shall be "Three P.bc, Inc." (the "Corporation").

ARTICLE II: INITIAL PRINCIPAL OFFICE

The street and mailing address of the initial principal office of the Corporation is 225 South Swoope Avenue, Suite 105, Maitland, Florida 32751.

ARTICLE III: PURPOSE

The Corporation is organized to transact any or all lawful business for which corporations may be incorporated under the FBCA as it now exists or may hereafter be amended or supplemented.

ARTICLE IV: SHARES

The total number of shares that the Corporation is authorized to issue and have outstanding at any time is 1,000 (one thousand), all of which shall consist of a single class of common stock with no par value.

ARTICLE V: CUMULATIVE VOTING

All shareholders are entitled to cumulate their votes for directors pursuant to Section 607.0728(3) of the FBCA.

ARTICLE VI: INITIAL DIRECTORS

The initial board of directors of the Corporation shall consist of such number of members as is determined by the undersigned incorporator. This number may be increased or decreased from time to time in accordance with the Corporation's bylaws, but shall never be less than one. The members of the initial board of directors of the Corporation shall be elected by the undersigned incorporator. Thereafter, the number of members of the board of directors of the Corporation, and the persons duly elected as members of the board of directors of the Corporation, shall be determined in accordance with the duly adopted bylaws governing the Corporation.

ARTICLE VII: INITIAL REGISTERED OFFICE AND AGENT
