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ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF SD RETIREMENT SAVINGS, INC.

The undersigned, acting as incorporator of SD Retirement Savings, Inc. under the Florida Business Corporation Act, hereby adopts the following Articles of Incorporation:

ARTICLE I - NAME

The name of the corporation is SD Retirement Savings, Inc. (the "Corporation").

ARTICLE II - ADDRESS

The Corporation hereby (i) designates One Independent Drive, Suite 1200, Jacksonville, Florida 32202 as the street address of the Corporation's registered office, and (ii) names Contega Business Services, LLC as the Corporation's registered agent at that address to accept service of process within the State of Florida.

ARTICLE VII - BOARD OF DIRECTORS

The number of directors may be increased or decreased from time to time, as provided in the Corporation's bylaws, but shall never be less than one (1). The following individual shall serve as a director of the Corporation until his successor is duly appointed or elected and qualified pursuant to the applicable conditions, provisions and terms of the Bylaws, or until the earlier of such director's death, removal or resignation:

ARTICLE IX - INDEMNIFICATION

The Corporation will indemnify each of its directors and officers and former directors and officers to the fullest extent permissible under applicable law. Except as prohibited by the Act, any such director or officer will be entitled to indemnification by the Corporation in any action, suit or proceeding (including any appeal thereof) resulting from the fact that he or she is or was a director or officer of the Corporation or is or was serving at the Corporation's request as a director, officer, employee or agent of another corporation, joint venture, partnership, trust or other enterprise, if he or she acted in good faith and in a manner that he or she reasonably believed to be in, or not opposed to, the Corporation's best interests and, with respect to any criminal action or proceedings, had no reasonable cause to believe his or her conduct was unlawful. The Corporation may, before final disposition of any action, suit or proceeding (including any appeal thereof), advance funds to pay for or reimburse expenses incurred in connection with such action, suit or proceeding by an individual who is a party thereto because her or she is or was a director or officer of the Corporation if the director or officer delivers to the Corporation a signed written undertaking to repay any funds advanced if (a) the director or officer is not entitled to mandatory indemnification under the Act and (b) it is ultimately determined that he or she has not met the relevant standard of conduct or is otherwise not entitled to indomnification under the Act, these Articles of Incorporation or the Corporation's bylaws.

ARTICLE X - JURISDICTION AND VENUE

Unless the Corporation consents in writing to the selection of an alternative forum or a federal court assumes exclusive jurisdiction, the federal and state courts sitting in the State of Florida shall be the sole and exclusive fora for (a) any derivative action or proceeding brought on behalf of the Corporation. (b) any action asserting a claim of breach of a fiduciary duty owed by any director, officer or other employee of the Corporation to the Corporation or to its shareholders. (c) any action asserting a claim arising pursuant to any condition, provision or term of the Florida Business Corporation Act, these Articles of Incorporation or the Corporation's bylaws, or (d) any action asserting a claim governed by the internal affairs doctrine. Any person or entity purchasing or otherwise acquiring any interest in shares of capital stock of the Corporation shall be deemed to have notice of and consented to the provisions of this Article X.
