

ORDER APPROVING REDOMESTICATION

Foremost Property and Casualty Insurance Company, ("Foremost Property and Casualty") a stock Indiana property and casualty insurer, has applied to the Michigan Commissioner of Insurance ("Commissioner") to redomesticate to Michigan pursuant to the provisions of MCL 500.412 et seq. Foremost Property and Casualty's application to redomesticate was filed on May 1, 1998.

Foremost Insurance Company Grand Rapids, Michigan holds 100% of the stock of Foremost Property and Casualty. The parent has been domiciled in Michigan since 1952 and for the past several years has reinsured 100% of Foremost Property and Casualty's business.

Foremost Property and Casualty indicates the purpose of redomestication is to have the ability to mainatin all of its books and records at the Foremost Group headquarters in Michigan. The redomestication will also be consistent with the present operations of the company.



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FINDINGS OF FACT AND CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

Staff has reviewed all submitted documents and information, and existing Bureau records that relate to this matter. Staff recommends the Commissioner approve the redomestication.

Based upon the foregoing considerations and the record in this matter, it is FOUND and CONCLUDED that:

- 1. Foremost Property and Casualty has requested approval of its redomestication from Indiana to Michigan.
- 2. Foremost Propety and Casualty Insurance Company is an Indiana stock property and casualty insurer, admitted to transact property, casualty and surety insurance business in Michigan.
- 3. The Articles of Redomestication and Amended and Restated Articles of Incorporation of Foremost Property and Casualty comply with the provisions of MCL 500.5000 et seq, and have been approved by the Michigan Attorney General and the Commissioner.
- 4. The Bylaws, as amended for the redomestication, comply with the provisions of MCL 500.5200 et seq.
- 5. Foremost Property and Casualty meets the capitalization requirements of MCL 500.410.
- 6. Foremost Property and Casualty has made a statutory policyholders deposit in Michigan that meets the requirements of MCL 500.411 and 912.
- 7. Foremost Property and Casualty meets the qualifying assets requirements of MCL 500.901.
- 8. Foremost Property and Casualty states in its application for redomestication that its administrative offices and principal place of business are located at 5600 Beech Tree Lane, Caledonia, Michigan 49316, pursuant to the provisions of MCL 500.412(1).
- 9. Foremost Property and Casualty has at least one director that is a resident of Michigan in compliance with MCL 500.5238.
- 10. Foremost Property and Casualty states in its application that its books and records are located at 5600 Beech Tree Lane, Caledonia, Michigan.

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ORDER

Therefore, it is ORDERED that:

1. The redomestication of Foremost Property and Casualty from Indiana to Michigan is approved when approved to be effective when effective in Indiana.
