Dear Ms Mortham:

TechKnowQuest is a 4 ½ year old business with seven employees. We anticipate passing the \$1M revenue mark for the first time this year. Due to a series of unanticipated turnovers this spring just prior to our Spring tradeshow season, the 1997 Corporation Annual report was overlooked. It is now May 6th. Tonight, I opened the Annual report form to find a \$550 fee is now due. This is over THREE times the original fee and is frankly UNAFFORDABLE. I fail to see how this will stimulate economic growth. The companies who are the most impacted by this are those (like us) that are struggling to build internal infrastructures to deal with the ridiculous quantity of rules, regulations and guidelines in Florida.

Doing business in this state is very frustrating. It seems to us that the focus is increasingly on attracting businesses from OTHER states into Florida by giving tax concessions and NO assistance made to small business starting from scratch. The legislature does not appear to have a clue what is actually involved in running a business. Thus far, in our short history, we have had to deal with:

- Being forced by law to pay an entire month of health insurance to an ex-employee and his family. The employee walked out the door one day with NO NOTICE to us, yet we could NOT legally terminate his insurance. This cost us over \$300.00
- We were forced by law to pay a \$2500 impact fee to add a single toilet and sink to our facility. The property management company was being sold and there were no records of their prepayment of impact fees on the site, so the City of Orlando made us pay this fee to commence construction. Having to earn the money for this fee held up the opening of our facility by three months and caused us to lose market advantage in our area!
- Annual "property" taxes on computer equipment that we use in our business to conduct business. This costs us over \$2000/year.
- And now this \$385 late charge.

I am left wondering why my business is incorporated this state.
