In going through our past records, I realized that we never received our Profit Corporation Annual Report Package for 1997 and 1998. On Monday, February 8th, 1999, we contacted your office regarding this matter; your agent informed us that our corporation had been dissolved!

In checking back, the renewals stopped coming since we moved to our new location at 11242 Commercial Way, just across the street from our old address of 11267 Commercial Way in Brooksville, FL. Although Change of Address cards were sent out, this may explain why we did not receive the packets for those two years.

Your agent mailed us the Application for Reinstatement that has been completed and enclosed. She told us to include a check for \$465, the amount owed to reinstate the corporation, and this letter explaining why we did not file for those two years. Also, our attorney had been taking care of this for us, but he retired and I took over the job in 1996. Having only done it once since the inception of the corporation, and since it is only a once a year job, it was not something that I would've remembered and would count on receiving the packet from you as a reminder.

I apologize for this oversight and hope you will spare the corporation any penalties that may have accrued because of the delay in filing. Your attention to this matter is greatly appreciated.
