I am a yacht captain by profession. I travel constantly and am usually trying to play catch-up with mail and paperwork. I paid \$150 to the Dept. of State as I was supposed to, but mistakenly used a similar looking check from a closed account. This account was an operating account from a previous vessel that I managed through my company. Since the account was closed the bank said nothing. The 60-day notice from your office was then sent to my accountant's office. They have no record of receiving it or passing it on to me. If I had received it I certainly would have corrected the error immediately. My first hint that I had made a mistake with the check was the Certificate of Dissolution that I received this morning.

Is there any way to reinstate my Corporation by simply sending in the \$150 and correcting the initial error? I am due to leave for Taiwan next week for 3 months on another job and I would like to resolve this before I go. I need the corporation in place to do my job.
