To whom it may concern:

Enclosed is our Application for Reinstatement together with our company's reinstatement fee of \$200.00.

We are aware of the dissolution of this corporation which occurred on August 23, 1996, and that normally we would be liable for reinstatement fees, however, we did not receive any of the original renewal documentation or notices. This is due to the fact that our company moved in February of 1996. According to our local post office, any mail sent to our prior building location cannot be forwarded to our new address because our old building, though it has many suites, each with different tenants, receives its mail as one mailing address (the management office then distributes that mail to its individual tenants). The post office informs us that they cannot forward our mail to the new address, because then their computer would forward the entire building's mail to our new address. They say they have no way to program the computer to forward one tenant's mail from that building.

We have repeatedly discussed this problem with the post office and with our old building's management office and they have agreed to try to hold our mail for us, but apparently different postmen are handling this situation differently and we have received some forwarded mail (which the post office says would have to have been manually forwarded by one of their mail delivery people-- and that they are not suppose to do that), but we still are missing a lot of mail. The little forwarded mail we do receive arrives sometimes months late. The only mail we received from the Division of Corporations was the enclosed application for reinstatement and we received it in late December.

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
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We apologize for the confusion and delay in filing our paperwork, but we have, we believe, done everything possible to get our mail and feel this is a highly unusual situation which we still have not been able to resolve to our satisfaction due to circumstances beyond our control.

Your telephone representative explained that the rules only make exceptions for late filings in cases where you have not received any reinstatement notices and write a letter verifying same.

We very much appreciate your consideration in this matter.
