The second condition for the above theorem is equivalent with the third condition, if we add the assumption that the mapping f is a $\mathcal{C}^1$ -mapping, that is, that the partial derivatives of the components of f are continuous. Then, in a paper of J. J. Moreau [1966], it is proved that if f is a $\mathcal{C}^1$ -mapping and if f is surjective, then f is open. The reason why the surjectivity is essential in the proof of the above theorem is that, if f is not surjective, then f is not open.
